### **Patient Allotment Guidance dated June 3, 2024**

#### **To be distributed to all cannabis patients, dispensaries, practitioners and caregivers.**

Patient purchases are now tracking to the exact minute for both the 7-day allotment and the 30-day allotment. The units will not drop off until the same time as the original purchase. For example, if you purchase today at 10:15 a.m., those units will drop off your 7-day on this same next day week at the same time. The same for the 30-day; if you purchase today at 10:15 a.m., those units will drop off your 30-day (30 days in the future) at the same exact time. Mississippi Medical Cannabis Units are governed by a 7-day limit and a 30-day limit. The maximum number of units in any 7-day period is 6 MMCEUs. The maximum number of units in any 30-day period is 24 MMCEUs. The system will always look at both time periods and will only allow you to purchase the lower of the two.

Note: It is not based on “weekly” or “monthly” and does not have to do with the week or the number of days in a month. It is 7 days and 30 days, respectively.

The system takes into consideration purchases made in the 7 days and 30 days prior to the current date. Furthermore, the rollover is time-sensitive, meaning the availability of a unit will be based on the exact time of previous purchases.

For example, if today is Monday, June 3rd:

- The 7-day limit takes into consideration all purchases made since Monday, May 27th
- The 30-day limit takes into consideration all purchases made since Saturday, May 4th

\*NOTE: As of July 1, 2024, Mississippi Medical Cannabis Units will be governed by a 30-day limit only. The maximum number of units a patient may purchase within a 30-day period is 24 MMCEUs, and a patient may have a maximum of 28 MMCEUs in their possession.
